



## Concept

Created by local architect, Steve Whettem, *Art at The Works* is a not-for-profit art gallery in Tavistock providing quality exhibition space for selected artists to showcase and market their work.

In contrast to a traditional art gallery, at *Art at The Works* artists self-manage their exhibitions, selecting, displaying, promoting and selling their work themselves. They pay a small fixed contribution to cover the cost of overheads, but retain all proceeds from any sales they achieve.

Open to the public on weekday afternoons, Monday to Friday, the gallery is available on a flexible basis to individual or multiple artists throughout the year. The minimum booking period is one week.

## Location

*Art at The Works* is situated on the ground floor of Stephen Whettem Architects in Dolvin Road, Tavistock, where it receives the attention of clients and associates visiting the practice, as well as the general public.



## Facilities

Suitable for wall-mounted exhibits as well as for sculpture and 3D work, the gallery offers approximately 16m of hanging length and 26m<sup>2</sup> of floor area, with an external courtyard providing an additional 16m<sup>2</sup>. A hanging system is provided.

Artists have full use of kitchen and toilet facilities. There is vehicular access for loading and unloading, and public car parks at nearby Abbey Rise and Abbey Place.

## Costs

A non-refundable administration fee of £15 is payable on application. Selected artists are charged an additional £60 per week, payable in advance, to cover the cost of overheads. All charges include VAT. No sales commission applies.

## Publicity

Publicity and promotion is down to exhibiting artists though guidance and support can be provided. Private viewings may be accommodated by arrangement (there may be an additional cost for this). Exhibitions will be listed on the *Art at The Works* website, with a link from Stephen Whettem Architects' website.

## Enquiries

The gallery is expected to play a key role in celebrating the work of exceptional local artists but expressions of interest from further afield are also encouraged.

Artists wishing to use the gallery will need to complete a gallery enquiry form and send it to the address below with 3 images suitable for use on the website (see enquiry form for details), a brief synopsis (100 words), a CV and £15 non-refundable administration fee.
